## Questions

- How can I make sure my installed CEMF functions after I change my machine hostname?
  - What hardware specification do you recommend for deployments?
  - Which IP address does the trapManager bind to if the host has multiple interfaces and more than one IP address?
  - What Solaris 2.6 patches should I install for running CEMF?

*Q. Which IP address does the trapManager bind to if the host has multiple interfaces and more than one IP address? (Products affected : CEMF 3.x)*

**A.** When binding to port 162 use **INADDR\_ANY**, which listens on any/all interfaces of the host. Running **netstat -a** exhibits that the machine is listening for UDP packets on \*.162. It does not matter which of the machine's IP addresses raise traps.
