# **Resolved Issues in Release 1.0.2**

Ref Number	Description
CSCuc06641	Issue—When WBPN boots up with LAN setting DHCP, the vendor class identifier, option 60 for DHCP packet is incorrect.
	Resolution—Vendor class ID changed to <b>Cisco WBPN</b> .

### **Release Notes**

Ref Number	Description
CSCuc17489	Issue—In a WPBN wireless setup by WPS with WRP400, there is failure in connection between WPBN and WRP400.
	Resolution—There is no WPS interoperability issue between WBPN and WRP400.
CSCuc17509	Issue—After factory reset of WPBN, when the WLAN LED is on, web login fails intermittently after changing username and password. Resolution—The problem does not occur anymore.
