## Introduction

This document describes the error "Failure: Unable to update boot configuration" when the administrator tries to update boot priority on StarOS (ASR 5000, ASR 5500, Virtual Packet Core) products.

## **Problem**

The error is reported when the boot system priority is updated:

## Solution

The error means that the configuration file is opened by another user.

1. Clear connected user and re-try to save the configuration. The command **show administrators session id** shows connected administrators and their session ID.

```
# show administrators session id
```

- # clear administrators session id <id>
- # clear administrators name <name>
- 2. Perform management card migration to clear any user connected to the node.
