### **Platform Event Filters**

A platform event filter (PEF) can trigger an action. For each PEF, you can choose the action to be taken (or take no action) when a platform event occurs.

## **Configuring Platform Event Filters**

#### Before you begin

You must log in as a user with admin privileges to configure platform event filters.

#### Procedure

**Step 1** In the Navigation pane, click the Admin tab.

Step 2 On the Admin tab, click Event Management.

**Step 3** In the **Platform Event Filters** area, complete the following fields for each event:

Name	Description
ID column	The unique filter ID.
Event column	The name of the event filter.

Name	Description
Action column	For each filter, select the desired action from the scrolling list box. This can be one of the following:
	• None—No action is taken.
	• <b>Reboot</b> —The server is rebooted.
	• Power Cycle—The server is power cycled.
	• <b>Power Off</b> —The server is powered off.

Step 4 Clic

Click Save Changes.

## **Resetting Platform Event Filters**

#### Procedure

Step 1	In the Navigation pane, click the Admin tab.
Step 2	On the Admin tab, click Event Management.
Step 3	In the <b>Platform Event Filters</b> area, click <b>Reset Event Filters</b> . Resets the event filters and displays the latest event filters.
