Campus Manager 5.0.3 is a software update for Campus Manager 5.0.2. In addition to the devices supported, this package contains fixes to both existing and newly discovered problems.

- You are prompted to enter your Cisco.com User Name and Password. If you have configured proxy settings, you are prompted to enter the Proxy Server User credentials.
- You can configure your Proxy Server User credentials from the Proxy Server Setup page.

Installing Campus Manager 5.0.3

Before you install Campus Manager 5.0.3, make sure your installation environment meets the requirements described in [“Hardware and Software Requirements” section on page 3](#).

To install Campus Manager 5.0.3:

-
- Step 1** Log into the machine as local administrator.
- Step 2** Navigate to the directory that contains the zip file that you have downloaded.
- Step 3** Unzip the package file cwcm5_0_3_win.zip to your temporary directory.
- Step 4** Navigate to the temporary directory where you have extracted the files packaged in the installer.
- Step 5** Double-click the file, cwcm5_0_3_win.exe, to begin installation.

A prompt appears:

This will install Campus Manager 5.0.3. Do you want to proceed?

Step 6 Click **Yes** to continue or click **No** to exit the setup.

If you have not installed Common Services 3.1.1, this message appears:

Install Common Services 3.1.1 before installing Campus Manager 5.0.3.

The installation terminates when you click **OK**.

Common Services 3.1.1 is available as a part of CiscoWorks LMS 3.0 December 2007 Update.

If you have not installed Campus Manager 5.0.2, this message appears:

Install Campus Manager 5.0.2 before installing Campus Manager 5.0.3.

The installation terminates when you click **OK**.

Campus Manager 5.0.2 is available as a part of CiscoWorks LMS 3.0 December 2007 Update.

Step 7 Click **Next** in the Welcome Screen to continue your installation.

The Software License Agreement dialog box appears.

Step 8 You should click either:

- **Accept** to continue

or

- **Do Not Accept** to exit the setup

The System Requirements window appears and the installation checks whether the system requirements are met.

- If there is not enough disk space to install Campus Manager 5.0.3, the installation displays an error message and stops.
- If the minimum requirements are not met, the installation displays a warning message and continues the setup.

Step 9 Click **Next**.

The Daemons Restart Options dialog box appears with the following message:

If no other CiscoWorks application installations are pending, you can choose to start CiscoWorks Daemons.

Do you want to restart CiscoWorks Daemons at the end of this installation?

If you want to start CiscoWorks daemons, click Yes.

If you do not want to start CiscoWorks daemons, click No.

Step 10 You should click either:

- **Yes** to restart CiscoWorks daemons

or

- **No** if you have any other installations pending

Bug ID	Summary
CSCso59624	Neighbor device information is not shown in Data Collection report and Topology Services for Cisco SAMI with Home Agent.
CSCso68976	In Topology maps, a single link between C2106WLC device and its neighbor is displayed twice. This happens when there is a mismatch between the MIB values of ifName and ifDesc.
CSCsk44148	Campus Manager incorrectly shows a FastEthernet link for WAE612 device. This occurs when you launch the Link Attributes report of the WAE612 device from topology maps.

Bug ID	Summary
CSCs108093	While searching for a root device with help of Spanning Tree Protocol, Campus Manager displayed additional root devices found.
CSCsm63631	Campus Manager Data Extraction Engine did not export the End host report based on a switch and a subnet.

Bug ID	Summary
CSCsm87821	Campus Manager 5.0.2 sent wrong authorization requests to the ACS server.
CSCsm97643	Ports with Multiple MACs report in User Tracking, displayed ports which had only one MAC address associated with it for a given device.
CSCsm66361	Online help for System Defined groups was incorrect.
CSCs197497	The IP Address field in the User Tracking end hosts report contained null value for certain entries, instead of a valid IP address.
CSCs127473	Data Collection results were not displayed, when Campus Manager was installed on Japanese Operating Systems.
CSCso14144	User Tracking did not properly reflect the usernames from Windows end hosts even when UTLite support was enabled. This occurred when there were duplicate entries for a given MAC address. In this case, the UTLite updates were ignored, and the username was not be written to the database.
CSCso26601	When the UT End Host report was launched from Device center, it displayed only a partial list of the end hosts discovered in the network.
CSCso36787	User Tracking deleted usernames at the completion of every UT Major Acquisition process.
CSCso24990	In the Campus Manager 5.0 > Configuration > VLAN Port Assignment screen, you were not able to search for ports using the port description set in the switch.
CSCsj95105	When you were managing 5000 devices on the same LMS Windows server, Data Collection did not run and errors were recorded in the log files.
CSCs171054	Data Collection metrics report did not launch for the last Data Collection completed.
CSCs196359	User Tracking end hosts records showed a few end host IP addresses with the ampersand (&) character at the end. At times it was reflected in the end host hostname field.
CSCso55021	Data Collection was not running properly and all the links in Topology maps were shown in red dotted lines. This happened if the hostname was null for some of the devices.
CSCs157852	Campus Manager Topology Services did not display any topology groups. Expanding one of the group trees resulted in an empty list. This occurred if there were a large number of user or system-defined groups configured on the system.
CSCs189095	New end host records were not added to User Tracking. This occurred if there were multiple entries in User Tracking with the same MAC address but no IP information.
