



Hardware and Software Compatibility Information for Cisco Unified Presence Release 6.0

Yes *	Compatibility tested with SCCP-based Cisco IP Phones; not yet supported with SIP-based Cisco IP Phones.
Not Supported	Known incompatibilities; do not upgrade.
New Install or Upgrade	The platform model is compatible with a new installation or upgrade of Cisco Unified Presence.
Future Release	The Cisco IP Phone model will be available in a future release.
Server EOS	The platform model is at End-of-Sale, and you can no longer order the server.
