



# Integrating CiscoWorks Wireless LAN Solution Engine with a CiscoWorks Server

---

You can use CiscoWorks Management Connection to add external application links to a CiscoWorks server's navigation tree. These links let you access applications directly from the navigation tree.

To add a link to a Wireless LAN Solution Engine, you install a connection to the WLSE's URL.

## Procedure

---

**Step 1** To access CiscoWorks Management Connection, enter the CiscoWorks server's URL in a browser (for example, <http://my-cw-server:1741/>).

**Step 2** Select **Management Connection > Administration > Create**.

Before a connection is installed, Management Connection ensures that folder and item names do not conflict with names on the local server and verifies that the URLs are active. After a connection is installed, the newly defined folders and items are added to the Management Connection drawer.
