



## END-OF-SALE AND END-OF-LIFE ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE CISCO DSL MANAGER

Cisco Systems® announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco® DSL Manager. The last day to order the affected products is November 30, 2005. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) until November 30, 2008. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product. Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement.

The Cisco DSL Manager is the element manager for the Cisco IP DSL switch. The end-of-life dates for the IP DSL switches were announced in March 2005 ([http://www.cisco.com/en/US/prod/collateral/switches/ps5704/ps298/prod\\_end-of-life\\_notice0900aecd80272b2e.html](http://www.cisco.com/en/US/prod/collateral/switches/ps5704/ps298/prod_end-of-life_notice0900aecd80272b2e.html)).

Last Shipment Date	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	February 28, 2006
End of Software Maintenance Releases Date	The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software.	November 30, 2006

Last Date of Support	The last date to receive service and support for the product. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete.	November 30, 2008
