### Product Overview

Cisco® announces the availability of Cisco Application Analysis Solution 2.0.

Cisco Application Analysis Solution (AAS) 2.0 provides a visual and quantitative breakdown of the complex interactions among applications, servers, and networks to cost-effectively troubleshoot and reliably deploy networked applications. It rapidly illustrates whether performance problems are due to network versus application issues. An optional Cisco AAS—Advanced Capture Module (AAS-ACM) works with the Cisco AAS “Capture Agents” to eliminate the need to manually launch an application trace but rather performs continuous or scheduled packet capture. This is especially useful when troubleshooting intermittent problems.

Table 1 describes the new features of Cisco AAS 2.0.

<b>Workflows for handling large traces</b>	Transaction identification and extraction
<b>Difference reports</b>	Detailed reporting on the differences between two AAS analyses
<b>Detailed summary of delays</b>	Separation of congestion and protocol as causes of delay Quantification of the effect of “parallel” causes of delay
<b>Multuser quick predict</b>	Part of AAS-ACM to enable rapid capacity planning for access links
<b>Decode enhancements</b>	Expanded support for MS SQL, VoIP, Citrix Decode for HTTP traffic over Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)–encrypted connections (if SSL keys are available)
<b>Capture Agent enhancements</b>	Simultaneous capture of network and system performance data Schedule capturing of packet traces with AAS-ACM
