Cisco® announces the availability of Cisco Application Analysis Solution (AAS) 2.1.

Cisco Application Analysis Solution 2.1 provides a visual and quantitative breakdown of the complex interactions among applications, servers, and networks to cost-effectively troubleshoot and reliably deploy networked applications. It rapidly illustrates whether performance problems are due to network versus application issues. An optional Cisco AAS – Advanced Capture Module (AAS-ACM) works with the Cisco AAS Capture Agents to eliminate the need to manually launch an application trace but rather performs continuous or scheduled packet capture. This is especially useful when troubleshooting intermittent problems.

| IPv6 import | Import capture files that contain IPv6 data |
| User Datagram Protocol (UDP) playback support | Characterize how applications perform using UDP |
| Decode additions | Support for Wireshark |
| Web report improvements | Reports contain more actionable information including graphs and statistics and customization |
| Capture Agent enhancements | Support for capture agents on Windows Vista and Windows x64 |
