

## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco 12000 Series Engine 1 8-Port Fast Ethernet Line Card

Cisco® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco 12000 Series Engine 1 8-Port Fast Ethernet Line Card. The last day to order the affected product(s) is April 7, 2007. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

Customers are encouraged to migrate to the Cisco 12000 Series Engine 5 8-Port Fast Ethernet Shared Port Adapter (SPA) to be used with the Cisco 12000 SPA Interface Processors (part numbers 12000-SIP-401, 12000-SIP-501, or 12000-SIP-601.) Table 2 provides relevant information for migrating to the replacement product.

Last Ship Date: HW	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	July 7, 2007
End of SW Maintenance Releases Date: OS SW	The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software.	April 6, 2010
