Downloading Cisco IOS Software Release 12.2T requires an active SmartNet Contract.

### **Product Number Format Change for IOS Releases**

From IOS Release 12.1 onward, the product numbers ("SKUs") in the Global Price List do not contain "dots" in the release number. The reason for not using dots is the field size limitation for the product number. Omitting the dots saves 1 or 2 characters.

Example:

New Format	Old Format (i.e., would have been)
SU92C8HK2-12101=	SU92C8HK2-12.1.1=
SC6MSFCAV-12101EX=	SC6MSFCAV-12.1.1EX= (would have exceeded an 18 character limit)
