



# Cisco NetFlow Flow Collector Version 3.x

Cisco Systems announces the end of life for the Cisco NetFlow Flow Collector, Version 3.x software (part numbers: NFC-SOSU-3.6, NFC-SOSU-3.6-UPG, NFC-SOSU-3.0, NFC-HPUX-3.6, NFC-HPUX-3.6-UPG, NFC-HPUX-3.0, NFC-SOSU-3.X-UPG, NFC-HPUX-3.X-UPG, NFC-HPUX-1.0, NFC-SOSU-1.0, NFC3.6) effective 02/19/03. The software will continue to be supported until the end-of-life date (see Table 1). All customers currently using Cisco NetFlow Flow Collector, Version 3.x will be able to upgrade to the Cisco CNS NetFlow Collection Engine, Version 4.0. The Network Data Analyzer version 3.6 (NDA 3.6) software will not be affected by this announcement. Cisco System Engineers can still download NDA 3.6 from the internal Cisco Web site at:
