

End of **Life** for Cisco **WAN** Manager Version 10.4



Overview

With the announcement of General Availability of Cisco WAN Manager (CWM) 10.4.01, the Multiservice Switching Business Unit (MSSBU) of Cisco Systems is announcing the EOL for CWM 10.4, with an effective date of May 16, 2001. Cisco customers will continue to receive Technical Assistance Center (TAC) support for CWM 10.4 until August 31, 2001, after which, all CWM 10.4 customers are expected to upgrade to CWM 10.4.01.

After May 16, 2001, CWM 10.4 will no longer be orderable from Cisco Connection Online (CCO) or Cisco Marketplace. CWM 10.4 will be replaced by CWM 10.4.01. Service-affecting bugs found in CWM 10.4 are resolved in CWM 10.4.01. If additional service-affecting bugs are discovered, they will be fixed in a patch or later release of CWM 10. CWM 10.4.01 is a maintenance release of CWM 10.4. All features supported by CWM releases 10.1, 10.2, and 10.3, and 10.4 are also supported in CWM 10.4.01. Customers are encouraged to upgrade any release 10.x systems to 10.4.01 as soon as possible.

CWM 10.4.01 can be used to manage the following product releases:

- Cisco MGX 8250 Software Release 1.1.3x, 1.1.2x
- Cisco MGX 8850 Software Release 2.0.1x
- Cisco MGX 8850 Software Release 1.1.2x, 1.1.3x
- Cisco BPX® 8600 Software Release 9.3.1x, 9.3.2x, 9.2, 9.1
- Cisco IGX™ 8400 Software Release 9.3.1x, 9.3.2x, 9.2, 9.1
- Cisco BPX 8600 Service Expansion Shelf (SES) Release 1.0.1x

Customers with current SAU contracts will receive upgrade versions of CWM10.4.01 from normal channels.

System Requirements

- Low-end network, less than 5000 connections; Sun Ultra 10 with minimum of 512 MB memory
- Mid-range network, 5,000 <= m < 50,000 connections; Sun Ultra 60/E250 with minimum of 1 GB memory
- High-end network, m >= 100,000 connections; Sun Enterprise 4000/450 with minimum of 2 GB memory

Definitions

- End of Sales—After this milestone date CWM Version 10.4 may no longer be ordered.
- Discontinue Contracts Renewal—The milestone date after which no maintenance contracts will be renewed.
- End of Maintenance—The milestone date after which no maintenance releases will be produced for the major release.
- End of Support/End of Life—After this milestone date the software release is no longer supported by CSE and is removed from CCO.
