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Swisscom sélectionne la téléphonie IP Cisco pour fournir l'infrastructure de communication du Forum Economique Mondial de Davos

*Les coûts réseau vont être diminués de moitié cette année grâce aux plates-formes Ethernet
VoIP sans fil de Cisco.*

Issy les Moulineaux, le 28 janvier 2005 – Cisco Systems, Inc. annonce que ses technologies IP (Internet Protocol), Ethernet longue distance (LRE) et Internet sans fil ont été sélectionnées par Swisscom, leader du marché des télécommunications en Suisse, pour fournir l'infrastructure de communication du forum économique mondial à Davos. Pour la première fois, les données et les communications voix pourront circuler sur un seul et même réseau réduisant ainsi les coûts d'installation et de maintenance.

Swisscom has provided the information and communications technology infrastructure for the World Economic Forum summit since 2000 and was asked to look at ways of cutting IT costs this year. The use of a single network for voice and other communications will halve installation costs and enable a 10 percent reduction in the overall IT budget. The network will cover the congress center and 20 hotels around Davos, and will be used by approximately 3,000 summit attendees and 500 staff. IP telephony infrastructure will connect 200 fixed-line IP phones and 40 fax machines, to complement the Swisscom mobile phones that will be available to each attendee.

Security features will be maintained through a combination of firewalls and VPN technologies plus three separate wireless networks, one of which will be used for public wireless Internet access while the other two are devoted to communications by and between attendees, along with applications such as electronic voting and polling.

“The integrated security features of Cisco network platforms was an important factor in our choice of infrastructure,” said René Fischer, CEO of Swisscom Solutions AG. “We were also keen to benefit from the flexibility of IP communications. The requirements of the users

are subject to change right up until the start of the summit and it is a great bonus that, with IP telephony, we can simply unplug a phone in one building, take it to another location, and have it working as soon as we plug it in without having to reconfigure the network.”

The World Economic Forum infrastructure is being installed in the four weeks running up to the annual meeting. It features a number of Cisco IP communications technologies, including Cisco [CallManager](#) on Cisco [7800 Series](#) media convergence servers, Cisco [Unity](#) unified communications software, Cisco IP Phone [7960Gs](#) (some with Cisco IP Phone [7914](#) expansion modules), a Cisco IP Conference Station [7936](#), Cisco [VG200 Series](#) analog phone gateways and Cisco ATA [180 Series](#) analog telephone adaptors. In addition there are Cisco [Access Control Servers](#), Cisco [2600XM Series](#) multiservice routers, Cisco [network modules](#) and WAN [interface cards](#), Cisco Catalyst® [3550 Series](#) switches and Cisco [LRE equipment](#).

“A robust communications infrastructure is a key ingredient in advancing economic and social programs and in helping to address many of the challenges and opportunities that face business and government leaders today,” commented Robert Lloyd, President of Cisco operations in Europe, Middle East and Africa. It is therefore very appropriate that at this year’s annual meeting delegates are able to benefit from just such a network which will offer a secure, flexible and cost-effective service with security features throughout the duration of the event.”
