



Cloud Computing: What does it really mean?




Cloud computing bundles remote services with user's data, software & apps and computation.




Cloud computing leads to cost reduction and higher productivity, providing means to capture previously unsatisfied demand...



Cloud Computing: A Disruptive Market Trend

Analysts size the worldwide public cloud services market at approx. U.S.\$131 billion (2013) growing at 18% a year over then next 3 years


Cloud impacts on Greek Economy: Capex Reduction

Cloud computing holds great potential to improve Greece's competitiveness € 14 billion in IT Expenditure Savings over the next decade (2011-20)

- ✓ Cloud replaces server and storage costs (CAPEX) with pay-as-you-go expenditure
- Productivity gains in IT departments by assigning
 IT professionals to more productive activities
- ✓ With no / fewer servers and data centres to power and cool, the companies face lower energy bills

Action	Private	Hybrid	Public	Cost item
CAPEX reduction	17%	31%	40%	IT CAPEX budget
Productivity gains	19%	24%	31%	IT labour costs
Power and cooling cost savings	44%	61%	79%	IT power and cooling budget
New expenditure on cloud services	0%	6%	13%	IT budget
