** These results were based on a pilot exit survey conducted by Cisco Worldwide Education in April and May 2004. Only students who were 3 to 5 months out of a CCNR course completed the survey. Approximately 1500 students participated. The sample was taken from students worldwide but a slightly higher number of students in the United States participated compared to the overall U.S. population of CCNA students participating in the Academy Program.
