

Cisco Hungary Awarded Best Workplace for Women

Cisco Hungary was recognized as Best Workplace for Women in a ceremony held in Budapest end September 2011. Cisco was awarded especially for the flexibility offered to employees when it comes to mobile working and work-life balance, as well as several local initiatives, including benefits for mothers, as well as sports and health.

The Best Workplace for Women competition has been organized in Hungary since 2007 under the umbrella of the Association for Women's Career Development.
