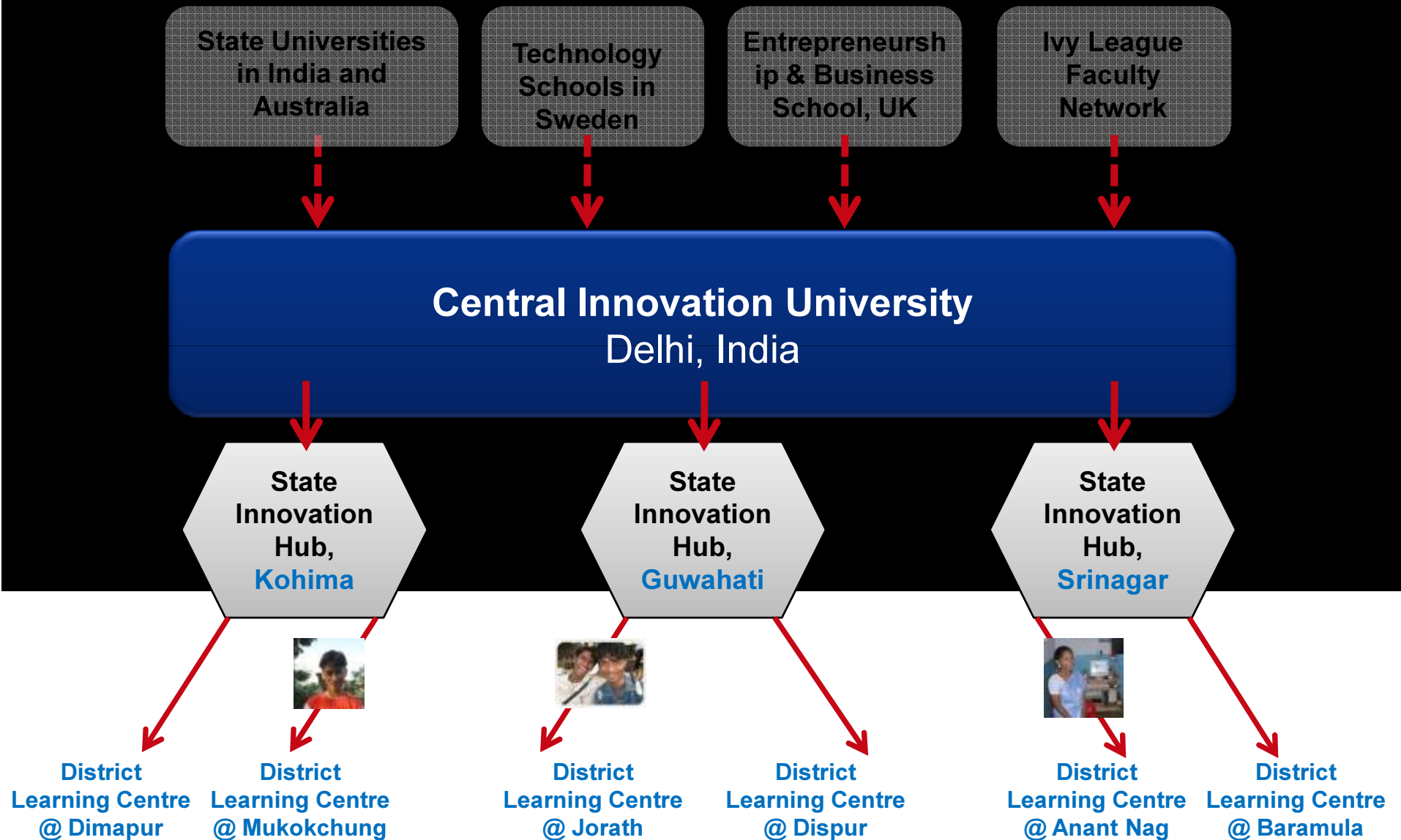

- Developing a new paradigm for higher education which could also be exported to other parts of the world

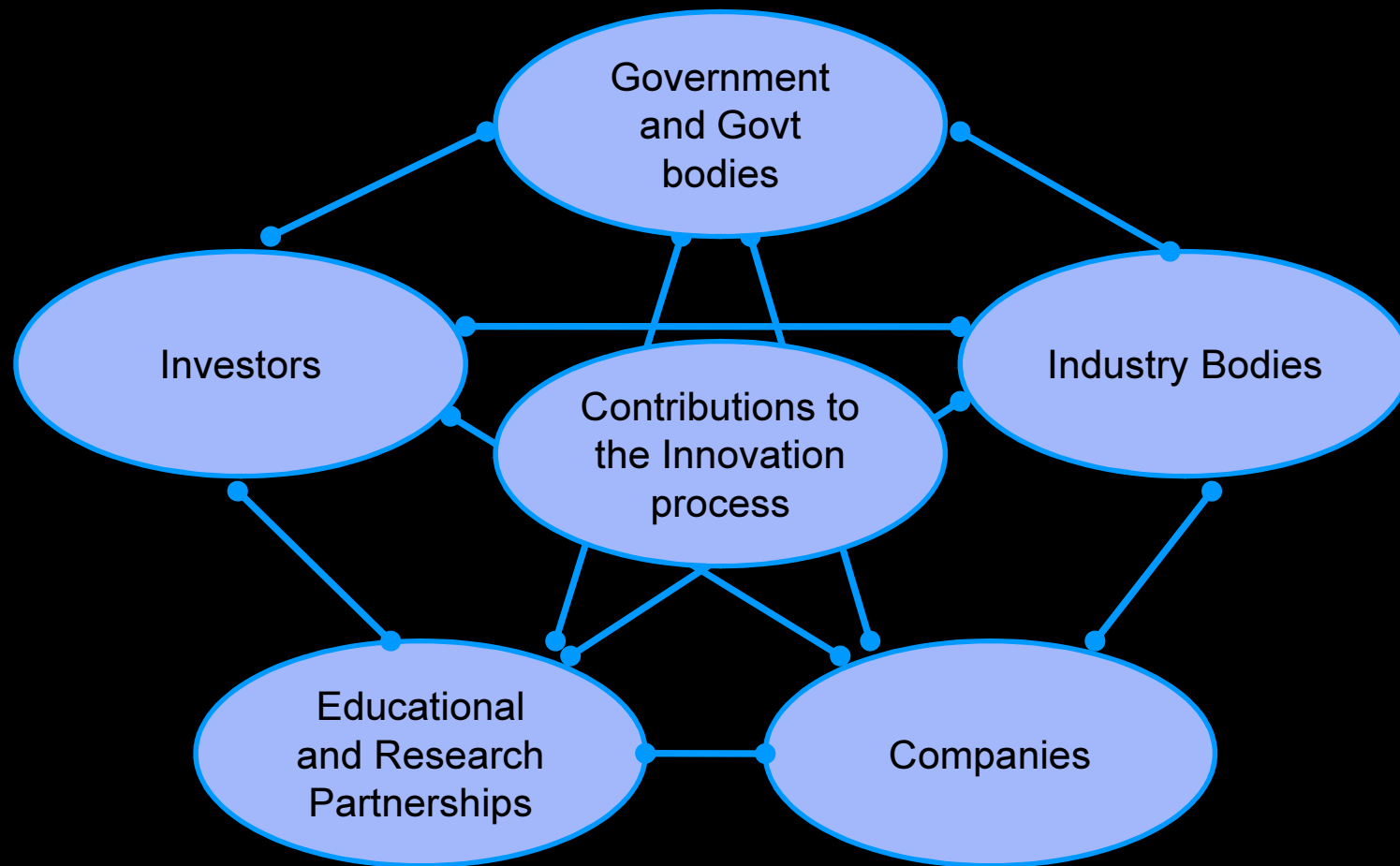
THE INNOVATION UNIVERSITY MODEL
