<b>Physical connections are established</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All cables inside the box are connected according to power or data keys.</li> <li>The jumpers are set properly on the motherboard and drives.</li> </ul>	25	
<b>All three computers power up and show a BIOS screen</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Computer powers up and a BIOS shows on the screen.</li> <li>BIOS is set to read CD-ROM or disk drives.</li> <li>Power is being delivered to monitor and PC.</li> </ul>	25	
<b>All drives read data</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The boot disk of the CD-ROM appears</li> <li>The A drive prompt (A:) can be read on the screen.</li> <li>Directories on the CD-ROM or floppy disk, if used, can be seen.</li> </ul>	25	
<b>Two partitions are set on each hard drive</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Installation program or FDISK has been run.</li> <li>Logical and extended partitions are set up. One partition is labeled FAT32. The other is labeled NTFS.</li> </ul>	25
