



## Free Cisco Certification Exam Voucher for Instructors

In support of the Cisco® Networking Academy® instructor community, Learning@ Cisco, the business unit within Cisco that is responsible for authoring and managing the Cisco portfolio of certification exams, and Pearson VUE, Cisco's primary vendor for test delivery, have developed an exam fee waiver program for **active instructors** in the Academy community.

Vouchers within this program will cover 100 percent of the cost of each Cisco certification exam for active Networking Academy instructors.

### Instructor Community

Learning@Cisco and Pearson VUE partnered with Cisco Networking Academy to develop this program because they recognize the importance of the Networking Academy instructor community, and the role they play in delivering networking education to students around the world.

### Eligibility

Active instructors are those who have taught a class with at least three students within the past 12 months.

### Availability

From early September 2008 through January 1, 2010, instructors will be able to access vouchers for 100% of Cisco certification exam fees from their Academy Connection instructor home page. 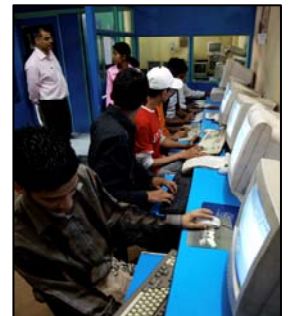
