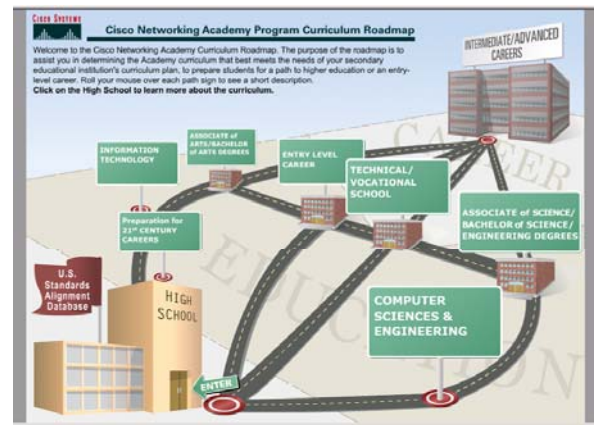
## What is the Cisco Networking Academy Program Curriculum Roadmap for Secondary Schools?

- **Example of high school implementation** – Examples of possible Academy curriculum planning and program implementation at the high school level

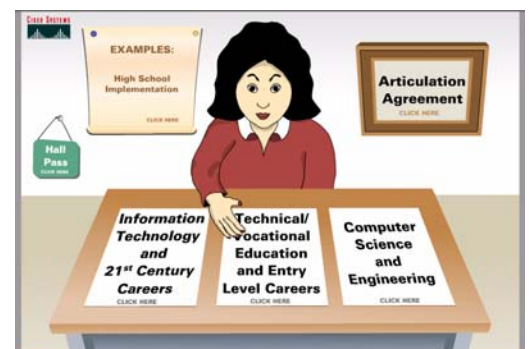
