Packet Comic: Hacker Busters

Hacker Busters are all about busting hackers. Doesn't that sound like a great comic book? Look at the digital images of the characters in the Peter Packet games. They're on this site for you to use and transform as you wish.

Think about using a few of these characters to create a comic book about the problems hackers create. Develop a storyline and a challenge for your characters to face.

Write a script for your comic book and explain what will happen in each scene. You may want to create a storyboard to map out what happens in your story. You can use poster board and include descriptions of each scene and pictures of your characters. You don't need to make storyboard for this, but you should have the plot, or storyline in mind.

The easiest way to complete the comic book is to use the characters as they are and put text under them in each scene. It may be more fun to modify the characters in a paint or photo-editing program like Broderbund Kid Pix® or Adobe Photoshop Elements®. You can use these programs to change the appearance, clothing, and position of characters. You can also use these programs to create backgrounds for your comic book.*

After your scenes are complete, put your comic together using a word processor such as AppleWorks® or Microsoft Word®, or add the text to your scenes using Kid Pix or PhotoShop Elements.

Check your work when you are finished and share your comic with others. Your teacher may want to have you present your comic to your class or to other classes in the school.

*If you don't know how to insert pictures into your comic or import characters into a paint or photo-editing program, ask your teacher or parents for some help. It's all pretty easy once you know the basics.
