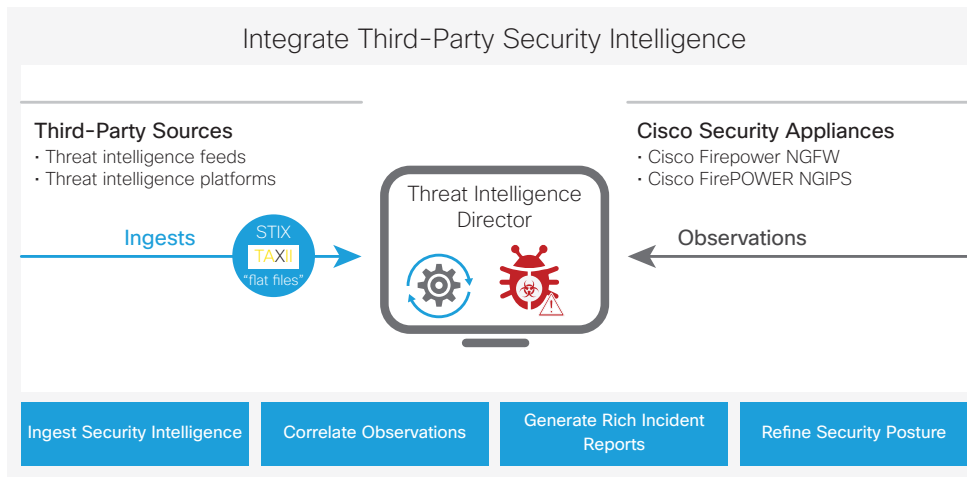

Operationalize Intelligence from Multiple Sources

By converting intelligence into actionable indicators of compromise, your network defenses can block or monitor more threats, reduce the number of alerts to review, and improve your overall security posture. By operationalizing the ingestion and distribution of additional threat intelligence sources, you reduce management complexity and the need to review and track down false alerts.
