SupplyPoint Systems was founded on a commitment to be the most trusted leader in intelligent vending and tool management. Their automated point-of-use inventory management systems help manufacturers reduce waste and become more efficient. With nine global locations and manufacturing operations in Europe and the United States, SupplyPoint's 150 employees serve customers in 30 countries, with over 38,000 machines installed across a wide variety of industries.

When the company started in 1998, they had even fewer staff—and no IT department. Everyone pitched in on security. SupplyPoint's products were standalone and all on-premise, so they could count on customers to secure their own networks.

But as technology progressed, SupplyPoint web-enabled their machines and expanded their solution. Now the company has a major web presence with a large application that handles 50 million inventory management requests per day. Since some of that traffic may contain threats, it's imperative that they take a more active security role to protect their equipment and customers that rely on their web services.

With the company's growth and extended solution, SupplyPoint added a small IT department. However, they still operate without a dedicated security team. Jeremy Rammalaere, Global SAAS Platform Manager in the research and development department, leads a team of two. These three are charged with supporting SupplyPoint's application and ensuring an excellent experience for customers, which includes management and everyday oversight of the infrastructure.

Coping with rising demands

So Rammalaere has to be strategic. To meet the high expectations of SupplyPoint's large enterprise customers, he's got to make the most of all his resources, both human and technical.

Current and new customers are adding to SupplyPoint's data center at roughly five percent weekly. At this rate of constant growth, his two staff members are at their limit with upgrades, replacements, and daily maintenance in addition to ongoing projects.

And yet they remain focused on fulfilling SupplyPoint's mission of trust. Rammalaere explains, "Security is in the forefront. We keep our customers' inventory and data safe and protected. It's our responsibility to make sure that none of their data is leaked to the public or their competitors, and that we maintain the highest level of data integrity that we can."

This can be challenging for just three individuals. He continues, "The amount of inbound threats we receive is my number one concern, tied with site reliability and making sure customers maintain the level of experience they hope to have on our site. Because security is, unfortunately, very lopsided. The good guys have to be good 100 percent of the time; the bad guys can get lucky once. As a result, the burden is on us to do everything we can to minimize risk."

SupplyPoint understands that security makes a real difference to real people too. According to Rammalaere, "We affect not only customers that depend on our equipment for inventory management, but the employees who work on the lines. If our customers have a data problem or if somehow we become responsible for a breach that causes a financial problem, that could affect all of those workers. (Security) can have a trickle down and ripple effect."

Additionally, along with better security, the integration of Cisco NGFWs with Cisco Stealthwatch Cloud has dramatically improved SupplyPoint's visibility into their traffic and data. Now they have contextual information and insights to make better decisions to solve problems. The Cisco solution also provides extra value by allowing them to do customizations as well as other integrations.

Behind the scenes, Cisco Talos provides a unique layer of security. Rammalaere says, "I'm sure I've taken advantage of protections that other people have seen before us that never even hit us. Other companies are using Cisco products and reporting attacks to Talos. Because it's already updated on our system, we get that advantage and protection and don't have to worry about it."
