## Changes In RV215W Firmware Version 1.1.0.6

### Enhancements in Firmware Version 1.1.0.6

Code optimization for the web-based Configuration Interface.

### Caveats in Firmware Version 1.1.0.6

#### **PFS Option in Site-to-Site VPN is Always Disabled (CSCue85378)**

The PFS is always disabled, even if it is enabled by using the GUI. The VPN peer must disable PFS to establish VPN tunnel.

Workaround: Disable the PFS option on the VPN peer.

### **Fails to Upload a Configuration File from a USB Device (CSCue88474)**

System continuously reboots when trying to use a USB drive to restore a configuration.

Workaround: Unplug the USB Flash drive to avoid rebooting, and restore the configuration from a PC.

### **The WAN Connection Does Not Reliably Recover from a 3G Link to an Ethernet Link (CSCue72776)**

The connection does not always failover to the Ethernet WAN link when the 3G connection fails, often when device is in IPv4/IPv6 Dual Stack mode.

Workaround: None.

### **Fail to Upgrade Firmware or Configuration File from NTFS Formatted USB Device (CSCue88485)**

Cannot use a NTFS-formatted USB drive to upgrade firmware or a configuration file.

Workaround: Use a drive formatted for FAT32.

### **Ratio of Passed Traffic is not Accurate on the LAN4 port when in Port-based QoS Mode (CSCuf24392)**

When port-based QoS is enabled, the queue schedule does not work on the LAN4 port; the ratio of passed traffic is not correct.

Workaround: Use the LAN1, LAN2, or LAN3 port instead of the LAN4 to use port-based QoS.
