Change in Behavior

While configuring the behavior of body and attachment scanning using the `scanconfig` command in CLI, you can specify whether to consider a ZIP file unscannable if the files in the archive are unreadable.

- 8.0.2-066

Defect ID	Description
CSCuq68930	In FIPS mode, <code>sshconfig > clustershow</code> command generates a traceback error and logs the user out of the CLI session.
CSCur11641	System gets corrupted while changing FIPS mode in a clustered environment.
