# These release notes support the Cisco Wireless Phone 840 and 860 software release 1.7(0). These wireless smartphones require:

#### Call Control

Cisco Unified Communications Manager

• Minimum: 11.5(1)

Recommended: 12.5(1), 14.0(1), or higher

Webex Calling

#### Wireless LAN Controller and Access Points

#### What's new in this release?

The following sections describe the features that are new or have changed in this release.

#### **Phone Volume Control Application**

The new Sound Stage application for the Cisco Wireless Phone 840 and 860 allows administrators to configure sound profiles and volume levels for the system and application sounds.

#### Ringtones per Line

Ringtone can be configured for each line from the Cisco Phone application on the Cisco Wireless Phone 840 and 860, where with previous releases, only a single ringtone could be configured that applied to all lines.

#### Maximum Battery Charge Cycles Notification

A notification will be presented when the Cisco Wireless Phone 840 or 860 battery has reached 500 charge cycles to inform the user that the battery should be replaced. The current number of charge cycles is visible in the Battery Life application when battery monitoring is enabled.

#### Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP) for Webex Calling

The Cisco Wireless Phone 840 and 860 now supports the Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP) feature for Webex Calling.

#### Local Phone Unlock Password for Webex Calling

The Cisco Wireless Phone 840 and 860 now supports the Local Phone Unlock Password option for Webex Calling.
