## New and Changed Information

This section describes the new and changed features in this release.

### Client Agnostic API Requests

With this feature, MOG enables to update/get/delete a session based on the virtue of the Session-Id for any subscriber. The earlier restriction of same subscriber who called POST API to call the PUT/DELETE/GET on MOG APIs has been removed. All subscribers with same Tenant name can execute the PUT/DELETE/GET on a session.
