### 1. Summary

This Offer Description is for Cisco Secure Application powered by the Cisco Observability Platform (the “**Product**”). The Product is a Cloud Service application that runs on the Cisco Observability Platform (“**COP Application**”) and provides deep visibility and actionable insights to help secure cloud-native applications as described in the Documentation available at <https://docs.appdynamics.com>.

1.1 **Support.** Your purchase of the Product includes [Enterprise Support](#).

1.2 **COP Application and Module Prerequisites.** You may purchase select COP Application(s) and Modules as an optional add-on. Modules are code, user experiences, or solution packages that function as add-ons to, or otherwise enhance, an existing COP Application. Use of this Product requires an active license for the Cisco Observability Platform and an active license for either the Cloud Security Module or the Data Security Module. Use of other COP Applications requires an active license for the Cisco Observability Platform, and use of the Modules requires active licenses for both Cisco Observability Platform and the applicable COP Application. In addition to the terms of the Agreement, end users are also subject to any terms applicable to the Module(s) they use, whether those are supplemental Cisco terms or the respective third party terms.
