



US SLED Appendix to the Cisco Enterprise Agreement Program Terms for End Users

If You are a U.S. State & Local Government End User (as defined below), this U.S. SLED Appendix (“**U.S. SLED Appendix**”) to the EA Program Terms is incorporated into and applies to the EA Program Terms. In the event of a conflict between the EA Program Terms and this U.S. SLED Appendix, this U.S. SLED Appendix takes precedence.

1. Definitions

- (A) “**Related Entities**” means You and any affiliated or related U.S. State & Local Government End Users.
- (B) “**SLED Contract**” means a direct purchase agreement between Cisco and a U.S. State & Local Government End User.
- (C) “**U.S. State & Local Government End User**” means a municipality, district, county, city, borough, commonwealth, state, tribal, or territorial government entity, including any agency, department, commission, bureau, board, council, authority or other entity in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of a state, local, tribal, or territorial government of the United States. For the avoidance of doubt, the foregoing includes: (a) public K-12 schools and public universities; and (b) any hospitals, medical centers, or health facilities that have constitutional or statutory authority to conduct public procurements or are operated by any U.S. state, local, territorial, or tribal government.

2. Applicable Terms

The EA Program Terms, the Buying Program Offer Descriptions and, if You are purchasing under a SLED Contract, the SLED Contract, govern the EA Program.

3. Order of Precedence

The documents comprising the EA Program Terms and the SLED Contract, if any, are complimentary, and to the extent possible, construed and interpreted consistently. If there is any conflict between the SLED Contract, the Buying Program Offer Descriptions, the EA Program Terms, and the End User Terms, the order of precedence is: the SLED Contract, the Buying Program Offer Descriptions, the EA Program Terms, and then the End User Terms.

4. Entire Agreement

The EA Program Terms, together with the applicable Buying Program Offer Descriptions, End User Terms and the SLED Contract, if any, are the complete agreement between the parties regarding the purchase of Cisco Technology and Services under the EA Program and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications, understandings, or agreements (whether written or oral).

5. Confidentiality

Cisco acknowledges that notwithstanding the Confidential label attached to the EA Program Terms, You may be subject to and required to comply with public record disclosure laws or the equivalent. Upon receipt of any public record disclosure request and prior to any disclosure, You will provide written notification informing Cisco of the request and afford Cisco the opportunity to assert any available exemptions permitted by law.

6. Related Entities

All references to Your Affiliates in the EA Program Terms shall be understood to refer to Your Related Entities.
