What is changing?

In response to growing customer and regulatory requirements for greater transparency regarding our handling of your data and to align with Cisco's data approach, we are publishing new Disclosure Documents on the <u>Trust Portal</u>.

Meet the new Transparency Stack

"General Disclosures"

This new document combines the content from the current Data Briefs on the Trust Portal for Personal Data, Customer Content, and Systems Information into one document, and modifies the type of data that falls under each category. The General Disclosures also includes a helpful table that explains the different types of data and how Cisco may access, use, and process that data. The <u>General Disclosures</u> replace the former Data Briefs on September 10, 2025.


"Offer Disclosures"

The new document combines the content from the existing Privacy Data Sheets and certain financial sector disclosure documents (DORA Disclosures) and incorporates new EU Data Act requirements to create one comprehensive, Offerspecific document.



1. General Disclosures for Cisco Offers

These General Disclosures describe how Cisco handles data across Cisco Offers and replace the Data Briefs previously published on the <u>Cisco Trust Center</u> and <u>Cisco Trust Portal</u>. Capitalized words not otherwise defined in these General Disclosures have the meanings set forth in the <u>Cisco General Terms</u>. Cisco Offer Disclosures contain information specific to an applicable Cisco Offer, which can be found on the Cisco Trust Portal and take precedence over these General Disclosures. If there is a difference in the translated, non-English versions of this document, the US-English version will take precedence.

2. Data Types and Handling

Cisco classifies data for Cisco Offers into four categories: (1) Customer Systems Information, (2) Customer Content, (3) Cisco System Information, and (4) Cisco Content. These four categories are defined below.

Cisco recognizes data included in any of the above categories may be considered Personal Data when associated with or related to an identified or identifiable individual. If Personal Data is included
