## Document, Application, and Screen Share

Share content or your entire screen with remote attendees in real time. Pass control to attendees so they can share content, or annotate yours. Figure 1 provides an example of content being shared with the active speaker and other meeting attendees.

View videos from up to seven attendees. Or select full-screen mode to view the active speaker in the main video panel, with other participants' video displayed as thumbnails. And for the most detailed video view, select the expanded fullscreen option to view the active speaker in true high-definition, 720p display resolution. Figure 2 demonstrates fullscreen mode. The video in the main panel automatically switches to display the person who is speaking, creating an intuitive meeting experience.

#### Personal Rooms

Meet even faster in your own permanent, personalized video conferencing space. Schedule ahead or leave your door open and let people drop in.

#### Active Speaker

Focus on who's talking with active speaker technology, which automatically displays the current speaker's video in the active speaker window.
