Service Delivery Programs

PUBLIC PREVENTION HEALTH FUND: COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION GRANTS

Supports the creation of healthier communities by funding capacity-building and intervention-based programs.

SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER

Addresses significant and pressing capital needs to improve service delivery and support the expansion of services at school-based health centers (SBHCs).

PREVENTION AND PUBLIC HEALTH FUND COORDINATED FOR CHRONIC DISEASE PREVENTION AND HEALTH PROMOTION PROGRAM

Provides funding to establish or strengthen chronic disease prevention and health promotion programs within state health departments.

NEW ACCESS POINTS

Establishes new full-time service delivery site(s) for the provision of comprehensive primary and preventive health care services.

TELEHEALTH NETWORK GRANT PROGRAM (TNGP)

Provides grants to demonstrate how telehealth programs and networks can improve access to high-quality health care services in underserved rural and urban communities.

Disaster Preparedness

HOSPITAL PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM (HPP) AND PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS PROGRAM

Supports programs that advance all-hazards preparedness and national health security.

Health Education

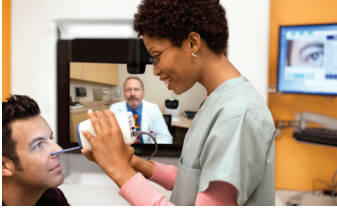
AREA HEALTH EDUCATION CENTERS

Supports interdisciplinary, community-based, primary care training programs.

H-1B TECHNICAL SKILLS TRAINING GRANTS

Provides education, training, and job placement assistance in the occupations and industries for which employers are using H-1B visas to hire foreign workers.

DISTANCE LEARNING AND TELEMEDICINE PROGRAM (DLT)

Designed to meet the educational and healthcare needs of rural America through the use of advanced telecommunications technologies.

TRADE ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND CAREER TRAINING GRANTS PROGRAM (TAACCCT)

Supports two-year, higher education programs for TAA-eligible workers and other adults seeking high-wage, high-skill employment, with a focus on providing innovative curriculum delivery and improving employment outcomes.

NURSE EDUCATION, PRACTICE, QUALITY AND RETENTION (NEPQR) PROGRAM— INTER-PROFESSIONAL COLLABORATIVE PRACTICE (IPCP)

Supports projects that strengthen the nursing workforce and improve nurse retention and quality of care.

Capacity Building

AFFORDABLE CARE ACT (ACA) CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT— BUILDING CAPACITY GRANT PROGRAM

Provides grants to existing Health Center Program grantees to improve their capacity to provide primary and preventive health services to medically underserved populations.

AFFORDABLE CARE ACT (ACA) CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT— IMMEDIATE FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM

Provides grants for facility improvement to address immediate and pressing capital needs of existing health centers receiving grants under the Health Center Program.

PUBLIC PREVENTION HEALTH FUND: COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION GRANTS

Supports the creation of healthier communities by funding capacity-building and intervention-based programs.
