Choosing the right certification to fulfill your requirements is important. Cisco offers certifications for Information Assurance Technical levels I through III, as well as Cisco Security Services Proxy (CSSP) Analyst and CSSP Incident Responder roles.

Information Assurance Technical

Information Assurance Technical (IAT) has three levels, defined by the DoD, each requiring certifications of increasing complexity. The appropriate certification qualifies the certification holder at different IAT levels and for IAT level-dependent roles. Level I are entry-level certifications, level II are intermediate, and level III are expert. Higher level certifications also fulfill the requirements of lower-level certifications.

IAT Level I and Level II

- **Cisco Certified Networking Associate (CCNA):** Prove you have what it takes to navigate the IT landscape. The CCNA certification validates your knowledge of networking fundamentals, IP services, security, automation, and programmability.

IAT Level III

- **Cisco Certified Networking Professional Security (CCNP® Security):** Master the skills and technologies you need to implement core Cisco security solutions to provide advanced threat protection against cybersecurity attacks.

CSSP Analyst and CSSP incident responder

- **Cisco Certified CyberOps Associate:** Validate your skills and knowledge in security concepts, security monitoring, host-based analysis, network intrusion analysis, and security policies and procedures.
