

## Cisco Partner Summit 2022 Attendance Health and Safety Policy

The health and safety of our attendees remains our primary focus. We continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and may adjust attendance protocols based on several factors including official government guidance, medical data, and specific event considerations.

### Vaccination:

---

Cisco will not require attendees to be fully vaccinated; however, it is strongly encouraged.

If traveling to the event from outside the US, please review the [U.S. Entry Requirements](#).

### COVID-19 Testing:

---

All attendees at the in-person event in Las Vegas will be required to present a negative COVID-19 test result taken within the 24 hours prior to picking up your badge (Antigen, Lateral Flow Tests used at home, Lab Tested Pre-Booked Antigen tests or PCR). *There will be no exceptions to this requirement.* If you test positive before traveling, please remain at home.

Attendees are encouraged to upload their test results to the approved 3<sup>rd</sup> party provider prior to onsite arrival. This will expedite your onsite registration process. Additional information will be provided closer to the time of the event.

Attendees with extended in-bound travel (longer than 24 hours) will have the option to do an onsite COVID-19 test prior to check in. These tests will be self-administered and verified by our 3<sup>rd</sup> party Health and Safety provider.

If you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the 14 – 90 days before the start of Partner Summit (between August 2 – October 17, 2022) and continue to test positive, you may bring a medical certificate of recovery to be exempted from the arrival test requirement. The certificate must be from a certified medical doctor or medical facility confirming your recovery and include a certified lab result demonstrating a positive test result during these dates. Please ensure that the name on these documents matches the name on your legal identification.

Attendees are strongly encouraged to complete COVID-19 self-tests every other day while in Las Vegas. Complimentary antigen tests will be provided at badge pick up.

Attendees who require an outbound PCR or antigen test for return home will have the option to have this complimentary test administered onsite by our 3<sup>rd</sup> party Health and Safety provider.

### COVID-19 Onsite

---

If you feel unwell or begin to experience any COVID-19 symptoms while onsite at Partner Summit, please remain in your room and do not attend the event or interact with staff or attendees.

Partners who test positive for COVID-19 while at Partner Summit are asked to follow their company policies and protocol for reporting and isolation. You will not be permitted to attend the remainder of the event, or any event-related gatherings.

Cisco employees who test positive for COVID-19 while at Partner Summit must follow Cisco's Policy and Protocol for reporting, as well as isolation requirements in an approved hotel room per CDC regulations for a period of five to ten days. Employees are asked to review Cisco's [COVID-19 Guidance for Partner Summit](#) on the program's internal SharePoint site.

### **Face Coverings:**

---

Attendees are encouraged to wear well-fitting face coverings while onsite in Las Vegas. Face coverings will be available at Partner Summit.

### **Other Considerations:**

---

Do not travel, attend the event or any event-related gatherings if you are feeling ill. Keynote sessions will be broadcast live during the event, November 1-2. Breakout sessions will be posted online at the same time.

If you were invited to attend Partner Summit in-person but are not comfortable traveling, you have the choice to join the digital event.
