## The 2028 technology landscape for Singapore

Our panel of experts developed a 10-year modelling scenario in which Singapore sits at the cutting edge of technological innovation, globally. Singapore has become a world leader in IoT-enabled logistics and supply chain optimisation. Semi-autonomous vehicles are commonplace and financial services heavily invested in AI and analytics.

## Jobs displaced

The three sectors in line for most displacement are:

- Wholesale & retail: 80k displaced (19.8 percent of workforce)
- **2. Manufacturing:** 55k displaced (22.1 percent of workforce)
- **3. Transport:** 50k displaced (23.8 percent of workforce)

## Jobs created

The three sectors in line for the most job creation are:

- **1. Wholesale & retail:** 100k jobs created (24.6 percent of workforce)
- Manufacturing: 70k jobs created (28.2 percent of workforce)
- **3. Finance & Insurance:** 60k jobs created (27.6 percent of workforce)
