



## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco Unified Customer Voice Portal 8.0

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco Unified Customer Voice Portal 8.0. The last day to order the affected product(s) is February 11, 2013. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

<b>Last Ship Date: App. SW</b>	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	May 12, 2013
<b>End of SW Maintenance Releases Date: App. SW</b>	The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software.	February 11, 2014
<b>End of New Service Attachment Date: App. SW</b>	For equipment and software that is not covered by a service-and-support contract, this is the last date to order a new service-and-support contract or add the equipment and/or software to an existing service-and-support contract.	February 11, 2014
<b>End of Service Contract Renewal Date: App. SW</b>	The last date to extend or renew a service contract for the product.	May 10, 2015
<b>Last Date of Support: App. SW</b>	The last date to receive applicable service and support for the product as entitled by active service contracts or by warranty terms and conditions. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete.	February 29, 2016
