Cisco announces the **end-of-life (EOL) dates** for the Cisco One Platform Kit (onePK) used for development, automation, and rapid service creation. The EOL applies to onePK solutions across Cisco IOS, IOS-XE, IOS-XR and NX-OS software operating systems. The specific dates for **EOL Announcement** and final releases that support onePK are listed below:
