- Cisco Video Surveillance Services Platform with Fibre Channel Connections: Provides Fibre Channel connections to external storage arrays, offering an ideal solution for organization that require the storage of a virtually unlimited amount of high-quality video data.
- Cisco Video Surveillance Services Platform with SCSI: Provides SCSI connections to external storage arrays, offering an economical option for organizations that require the storage of high-quality video data.

Both models work with Cisco Video Surveillance Stream Manager Software, provide high-quality MPEG-4 encoding, and offer numerous features in a single component that is easy to use and deploy.
