

## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco 12000 Series SPA Interface Processor-600

Cisco® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco 12000 Series SPA Interface Processor-600. The last day to order the affected product(s) is December 13, 2008. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

<b>End of SW Maintenance Releases Date: OS SW</b>	The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software.	December 13, 2011
<b>End of Routine Failure Analysis Date: HW</b>	The last-possible date a routine failure analysis may be performed to determine the cause of product failure or defect.	December 13, 2009

<b>End of Service Contract Renewal Date: HW</b>	The last date to extend or renew a service contract for the product.	March 13, 2013
<b>Last Date of Support: HW</b>	The last date to receive service and support for the product. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete.	December 12, 2013
