The last day to order the Multiprocessor Forwarding (MPF) on Cisco 7200 NPE-G1 and Cisco 7301 for Broadband LAC, LNS, and PTA is December 28, 2007. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the Multiprocessor Forwarding (MPF) on Cisco 7200 NPE-G1 and Cisco 7301 for Broadband LAC, LNS, and PTA.
