



## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco ISE Base Migration

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco ISE Base Migration. The last day to order the affected product(s) is November 30, 2017. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available under the terms and conditions of customers' service contract.
