Cisco® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco Catalyst 3750-E IOS Advanced IP Services Feature Set. The last day to order the affected feature (s) is April 17, 2009. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

The functionality currently available in the Cisco Catalyst 3750-E IOS Advanced IP Services feature set switch is now available in the Cisco IOS 12.2(50)SE IP Base and IP Services feature sets. This reduces complexity by not requiring customers to upgrade software to utilize advanced IPv6 features.
