

## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco MGX OC-192 Intermediate-Range Back Card

Cisco Systems® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco MGX OC-192 Intermediate-Range Back Card. The last day to order the Cisco MGX OC-192 Intermediate-Range Back Card is January 31, 2007. Milestone	Definition	Date
<b>End-of-Sale Date</b>	The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date.	January 31, 2007
<b>Last Ship Date: HW</b>	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	June 14, 2007
<b>End of Routine Failure Analysis Date: HW</b>	The last-possible date a routine failure analysis may be performed to determine the cause of product failure or defect.	March 15, 2008
<b>End of New Service Attachment Date: HW</b>	For equipment and software that is not covered by a service-and-support contract, this is the last date to order a new service-and-support contract or add the equipment and/or software to an existing service-and-support contract.	March 15, 2008
<b>End of Service Contract Renewal Date: HW</b>	The last date to extend or renew a service contract for the product.	June 12, 2011
<b>Last Date of Support: HW</b>	The last date to receive service and support for the product. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete.	March 14, 2012
