

End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco Unified Communications Manager 7.0

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco[®] Unified Communications Manager 7.0. The last day to order the affected product(s) is April 12, 2010.
