



## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco MCS 7825-I1 Media Convergence Server

Cisco Systems® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco® MCS 7825-I1 Media Convergence Server. The last day to order the affected product is May 24, 2006. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) until July 13, 2011.
