

## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco Unified Mobility Standalone Application

Cisco<sup>®</sup> announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco Unified Mobility Standalone Application. The last day to order the affected product(s) is August 16, 2009. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

Starting with Cisco Unified Communications Manager 6.0, it becomes integrated natively into Cisco Unified Communications Manager. Customers can now save time and money, as no incremental server is required and administration is combined into Unified Communications Manager Administration pages. The original standalone application has reached its end-of-sale date with this announcement. Cisco Unified Mobile Communicator and Cisco Unified Mobility Advantage are separate products and are not affected by this announcement.
