

## Change in Product Part Number Announcement for the Cisco Aironet 2.4 GHz Diversity Omnidirectional Antenna AIR-ANT3213

Cisco announces a change in product part numbers for the Cisco Aironet 2.4 GHz Diversity Omnidirectional Antenna AIR-ANT3213. This is a product part number change only announcement.
