## Introduction

This document describes to how to run a "whoami" type of request against CIS.

## How can I identify the current username from a CIS client session?

There are two operations to choose from.

You can call or publish this native CIS procedure: `/lib/util/GetProperty` and pass in this input parameter: `CURRENT_USER_NAME`. The response will simply be the user name during that session.

**OR**

The client can make a call against this native web service admin API located at:

`/services/webservices/system/admin/user/operations/getUser`

and this will be one of the elements in the response:

`<user:name><your user name></user:name>`
